You will be TAKING ALL 12 STEPS IN A FOUR WEEK PERIOD. We encourage you and suggest that you continue and deepen your Step Work with your Sponsor, within your DA meeting and within another Step Study Group.

 The step workshop sessions are presented as follows: Session 1: Overview and Step 1
Session 2: Steps 2, 3 & 4
Session 3: Steps 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9
Session 4: Steps 10, 11 & 12
Session 5: Overview of and Getting Started in Debtors Anonymous

The e-mail invitation will contain the telephone number and access code for the conference call AND the link to connect with the Share Plus (desktop sharing) feature. 9. Attendees will be assigned a sharing partner during the first session. Sharing partners may or may not be members of The DA Fellowship that have 'graduated' from previous step workshop sessions. Every effort will be made to match attendees up with sharing partners from the same time zone.
